Project included the design of electrical systems to eliminate or correct electrical deficiencies throughout the 800,000 SF facility. Replacement of the primary 12.47KV double ended switchgear and four 15KV underground feeders, design of a campus-wide lighting system, consolidation of over 25 panelboards, replacement of various disconnect switches with high rated AIC equipment were all part of the project. All construction plans and specifications were completed for bidding within a 90 day time frame.
